## PREVIOUS MEETING (JANUARY) NOTES FOR REFERENCE BELOW:

- Financial Report
  - Ann sent report via email to the board.
  - o Collected net of 7500 in dues plus 1000 from Poland Spring, nothing from the town of Poland
  - One expense for the newsletter paid in Oct. was \$813.
  - July was \$7400 ending 14.122 with 6 deposits.
  - Waiting on Scott's bill to come in (usually comes in around March) which is usually around \$6,000.00.
  - Scott is retiring not sure of his replacement.
  - Barry did an invoice to the town for a bill to \$1,000 which kicks out a reimbursement. This
    includes the water testing. This usually comes in around March.
- Water Level/Beaver Update
  - We had a neighbor, Eric Anderson, from Middle Range who helped with this. We are asking him to speak at the next meeting. He and other volunteers completely removed the beaver dam on Lower.
  - Barry will coordinate with town and public works and Scott Lindsey, the Maine Biologist, so Eric's work was very helpful. They took it right to the foundation of the old walkway.
  - Jim Webster will be setting traps this winter and will stay in touch. He got two beavers last year. The den was rebuilt, so we are hoping to get all of them.

- We authorized \$300, for the removal.
- Water levels were good for the winter.

# Mooring Subcommittee

- No activity John has five volunteers to work on the subcommittee.
- Path forward consists of preparing something based on neighboring community ordinances.
- We will reach out to the Poland Town council for an ordinance.
- The work of the committee is to look at existing ordinances in other communities then move forward with approaching the council.
- o There was a council member at our previous meeting willing to help.
- John will send an email to the people he has addresses for and will schedule a meeting to discuss it and begin to push it forward.
- Question: Could we reach out to Tripp to get greater town wide support for this? Do we have a contact for the Tripp Lake Association? Ann will contact this association.
- Would the selectboard be able to initiate something? (unsure would have to check)
- Barry can help meeting with the selectboard.
- Naples and Casco have ordinances to review.
- o Jane Benthany was at the meeting and offered to assist. We can also check into Raymond.
